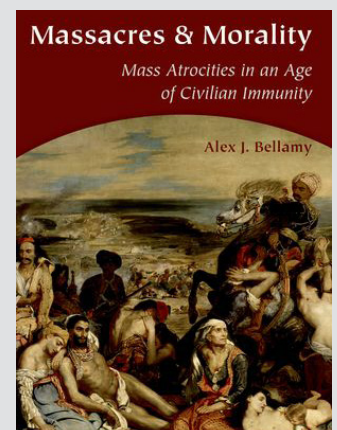

The book argues that although the world has made impressive progress in legislating against the intentional killing of civilians and in constructing institutions to give meaning to that prohibition, the norm's history in practice suggests that the ascendancy of civilian immunity is both more recent and more fragile than might otherwise be thought.

Bellamy is Professor of International Security, Griffith Asia Institute/Centre for Governance and Public Policy, Griffith University, Australia and Non-Resident Senior Adviser at the International Peace Institute, New York. He is also Director (International) and Founding Director (2007-2010) of the Asia Pacific Centre for the Responsibility to Protect (AP R2P).
